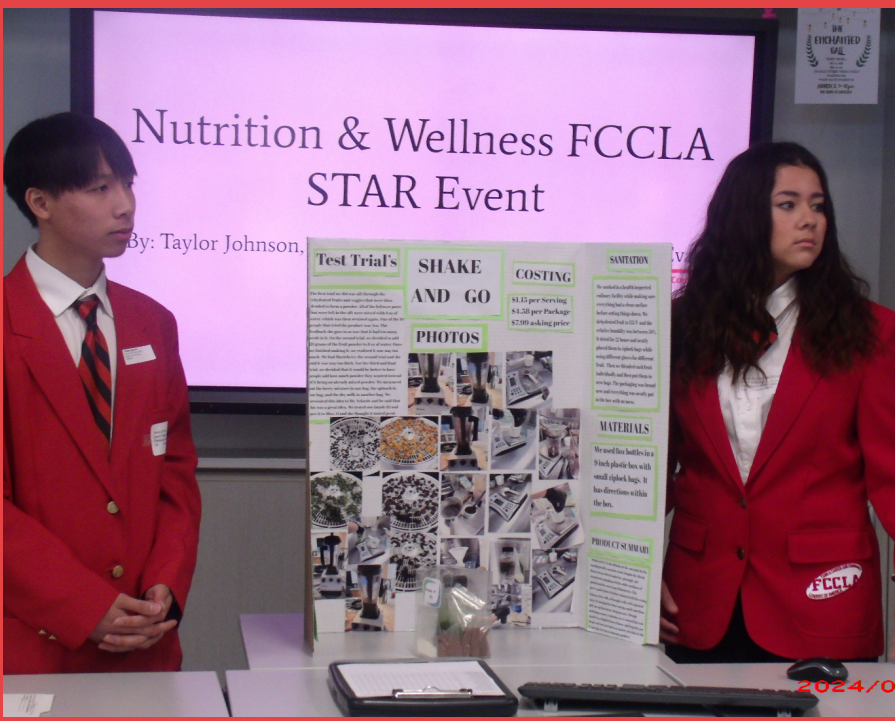


Spring Meeting
