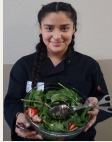


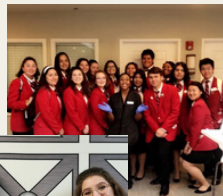
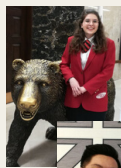
VIRTUAL REGION 2 MEETING

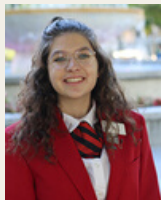
